



Organic Farmers' Market Now in its sixth year, the Port other locally grown fruits are mouth Washington Farmers' Market is a popular destination on Saturday mornings. Located on the Town Dock, there is ample room for park-

ing and lingering over a cup of organic coffee and oven-warm muffins and scones in the new

Market Café.

This is also the place for those looking for a source of local, sustainably grown food. (Note: these enlightened people are known as locavores and can be identified by their healthy glow!)

Early summer offerings include lettuces, spring onions, strawberries, peas, sorrel and a variety of greens.

As the season continues, farmers bring in their tomatoes, peppers, eggplants, squashes, beans and other just-picked summertime vegetables. Early fall brings winter squashes, pumpkins, root vegetables and corn. The berries, peaches, melons and watering and so much sweeter than their store-bought cousins. Other vendors include Nordic Bakers (and brothers) who produce an incomparable Finnish rye, and a local Port Washington beekeeper.

The market is the only 100%



organic market in New York State and is growing each year, drawing new customers from Port and surrounding communities. Open Saturdays, June-October, from 8am until noon, rain or shine.






