First Execution Rocks Lighthouse Tower Climb

Whether passing Execution Rocks by boat or looking down on it from the Throg's Neck Bridge, how many of us have wondered what it was really like inside that landmark?

July 4 begins a schedule of opportunities to do just that...boat out to Execution Rocks, climb the protective rocks and go inside this tower built more than 100 years ago.

Congress commissioned the lighthouse in 1847 because the rocks created a safety problem for ships navigating the Sound. It was designed by Boston's Fanueil Hall architect Alexander Parris, and built in 1849. The Keepers House was built in 1867.

Visiting Execution Rocks

The initial public visit scheduled for July 4 begins at 9:30 am at the Town Dock and returns about 2:00 pm. Pack a lunch and take the \$25 Water Taxi ride to the Rocks. While not for the faint of heart or out of shape, (wear appropriate clothing and boat shoes or sneakers) your visit will give you a first hand view and understanding of the historic site and why its preservation is important to all.

Preserving the History

A brand new non-profit group, Historically Significant Structures, has been awarded access rights to this intriguing spot, along with an obli-



gation to refurbish and maintain the facilities. Historically Significant Structures is a non-profit organization established to raise funds to restore, renovate, preserve and operate Execution Rocks and similar structures that are part of our American Heritage.

While donations are encouraged, the visit is free. Other visitors who take their own transportation to Execution Rocks while the tour is ongoing are welcome.
