REMINDER: SCHOOL STARTS SEPTEMBER 9

Fall Driver Ed Classes Starting Soon

The PW School District's Office of Educational and Community Education will offer a New York State Approved Driver Education program for Port Washington students this fall. The 16-week program will include 24 hours of classroom instruction, plus homework, and 24 hours of driving instruction, with each student spending 6 behind the Additional driving practice, outside of class, is required. The fall semester will run from Sept 9, 2009 until Jan 25, 2010. Classes are available after school and on Saturdays. Attendance at all sessions is mandatory according to state law. Therefore, students must be sure they are able to attend all sessions before registering.

Only high-school students who reside in the Port Washington school district can enroll. Students must be 16 years old and have a valid learner's permit by Sept. 1, 2009. A copy of this permit must be submitted to our office before classes begin. Registrations are accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Students who successfully complete the requirements for this non-credit course will receive Student Certificate Completion (MV285) and an insurance premium reduction letter. Please be aware that even after receiving this form and passing a road test, a 16-year old is

not eligible for a regular license.

Classroom instruction and driving sessions will be held at Schreiber HS after school and Saturdays. The total cost for the program is \$530.


All eleventh and twelfth grade students within the school district will be receiving an information packet and enrollment form in the mail. If an interested student attends a non public school and lives within the district, he or she can receive the forms by calling the Office of Educational and Community Education at 767-5470. Students who have misplaced their forms can get new ones in the Administrative Annex at 90 Avenue C, in the Schreiber High School Guidance office, or can download the forms from www.Portnet.k12.ny.us

Students are advised to register as soon as possible after receiving their form since registration is limited. Classes are canceled if there are not enough students. A limited number of full and partial scholarships are available for students who receive free or reduced lunch. These students should submit the registration forms with a written request for scholarship assistance.

Registration can be done through the mail, using the registration form students received or by faxing 767-5479 and paying by credit card.


