Early registration helps in planning for necessary staff and also ensures that any necessary placement tests are completed.

Appointments Required

Registration for all students begins Mon., Jan. 11, and continues through Fri., Feb. 26, 2010. You must make an appointment to register your child by calling 767-5470 from 8:30 am - 3:30 pm. Registration for all schools is in the Department of Community Services in the Administrative Annex at 90 Avenue C. The entrance is located on the south side of the Daly Elementary School.




