#### **Sandminers Monument Dedication**

A dedication ceremony for the Sandminers Monument will take place Sat. Sept. 25, 11 am at the monument site on West Shore Rd., just south of the Harbor Links Golf Course.

This monument is dedicated to honor and remember the immigrant workers who toiled under perilous conditions. Through their labor, prized "Cow Bay Sand" was barged from Hempstead Harbor to become the concrete that built the skyscrapers, tunnels and bridges of New York City. Many of these miner's descendents became prominent members of the Port Washington community.

The dedication ceremony and reception are free and open to all. An Opera Luncheon at Harbor Links Club House following the



dedication (\$75pp), features a musical presentation by Maestro Vincent La Selva and the New York Grand Opera Company, and supports the work of the Sandminers Monument, Inc. Contributions from the event will be used to complete the historical graphic panels, memorial walkway and overall project.
