While most of us won't outlive the library's 120 years, this program promises to help you get as close as you can.

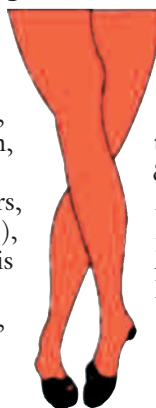

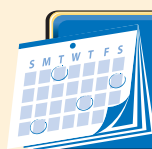
