It has grown into a major Long Island festival on the shores and in the waters of Manhasset Bay. This year the HarborFest Dock Day will be Sunday, June 2, from 10AM to 5PM.

Entertainment is provided by the nautical singing group, "Stout" and encore performances by the cast of the "Red Stocking Revue." The "Pride of Cow Bay" nautical museum will unveil a new exhibit. Art in the Park is back, and many wonderful merchants have booths on the dock. The HarborFest Fabulous Food Court offers gourmet selections from Port's finest restaurants, in addition to popular and delicious festival food.
