





Who do you believe?

We are writing this as August is rapidly coming to a close. Fall and Winter are staring us in the face... and the pocketbook. (Do they call them that anymore? I am paranoid since discovering that most of the world had no idea who Pogo was).

Then on Monday last, I received a basic increase of "just 3.25%" on a bill we receive each month... and, of course the note told me how lucky I was...

That same day, we received word that our eblast provider was going up 'just' \$5 per month...that's \$5 on a \$39 bill... 'just' over 12%. Again, the note told me how lucky I was.

The Moral on all this 'Luck'?

Shop quick (and Local), before something else goes up.
