## The Art Guild Announces Classes for Children and Adults

An electrical fire at Elderfields Preserve in 2011 during Hurricane Irene forced The Art Guild to suspend all classes and activities. In September, installation of a fire alarm system allowed The Guild to once again open its doors to the public.
