2015 Port Washington - Manhasset Bay Kayak Run, July 18

Paddling around Manhasset Bay on Saturday, July 18, at the 11th Annual Port Washington-Manhasset Bay Kayak Run is not only a fun event, but is a win-win for everyone – with the entry fees benefitting the Community Chest of Port Washington, an organization that helps change the lives of Port residents in need.

This event is presented by the Town of North Hempstead and the Community Chest, with major assistance from Atlantic Outfitters. The event starts at 10 am and participants (in kayaks, canoes or paddleboards) paddle at their own pace, leisurely or full steam ahead along the Bay's five mile course, to designated locations. At 12:30 pm, paddlers go ashore at the Town Dock, for a raffle drawing. The top prize is a kayak and many other prizes are awarded.

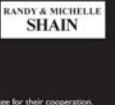
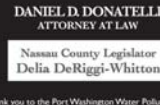

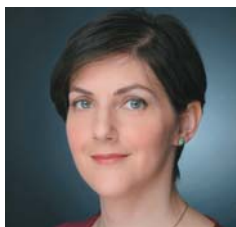
